## **ELEMENTS OF RISK**

Educational activity programs, such as activities mentioned above, involve certain elements of risk. Injuries may occur while participating in these activities. The following list includes, but is not limited to examples of the types of injury, which may result from leaving the school grounds.

- 1. Traffic accidents that may occur while traveling by bus to West Edmonton Mall and returning to Clear Vista School.
